




Incoming Exchange Students On-Campus Housing Information

Students from partner institutions studying abroad at université de Nantes can request on-campus housing on the online application.

Attention: The number of places in the residence halls is very limited and we cannot guarantee to meet all the accommodation requests. To increase the chances of being placed in a residence hall, students should apply early.

2. Reservation Periods for Residence Halls

Reservation periods are fixed and cannot be modified!




If a student decides to move out of his/her room before the end of the lease, he/she will be obliged to pay rent until the end of the lease.

 **Please Note:** Students can request to extend their room reservation for the 2nd semester or for the summer for academic reasons only. Requests will be reviewed and they may only be granted based on vacancies at the period requested. More information will be available upon arrival in Nantes.

3. Room Assignments

 Students do not choose their residence halls. The staff at the International Relations Office of université de Nantes will assign rooms to students depending on the availability of on-campus housing. No requests for changes in residence halls will be taken into account.

Students will receive a definite answer regarding room assignments between **July 1st and 10th** for 1st semester and full year requests and between **December 10th and 15th** for 2nd semester requests.

 Room assignments are not definite until the student confirms the reservation.

4. Additional Information

Rent is to be paid directly at the residence hall before the 10th of each month.

Students can purchase a bedding kit upon their arrival at the residence hall. The kit costs 25 €*.

Bedding Kit: sheets, 1 blanket, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase.

In some residences, students can only purchase a disposable bedding kit for their first days in Nantes. This kit costs 15 €*.

5. Arriving at the Residence Halls

Students **must come by the Guichet Unique** at the International Relations Office before they can check in at the residence halls. <http://www.univ-nantes.fr/guichetunique>

Check in time is from Monday to Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and between 1:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Students will not be allowed to move in on weekends. If students cannot arrive during the opening hours, they will need to book a hotel room.
