### **INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS**

## FRENCH LANGUAGE SUPPORT CLASSES

[2019-2020]

International exchange students will have the opportunity to enroll in French Language Support Classes at Institut de Français langue étrangère (i-FLE) during their study abroad period at Université de Nantes. In order to benefit from these free, non-credit bearing courses, students interested shall request enrollment during the online application process.

Exchange students will have three options:

- French Language Support classes for the 1st semester.
- French Language Support classes for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
- French Language Support classes for the entire academic year.

Students having requested enrollment will receive at the beginning of each semester detailed information about the French Support classes via e-mail.



Important! Exchange students enrolled in the DUEF French semester course at i-FLE cannot benefit from the French Language Support Classes since these are in priority for exchage students enrolled in other faculties at the university.

#### **PROGRAM**



Classes will take place **twice a week** during **ten weeks** (each semester), usually from **5:45pm to 7:45pm**. Students will need to take a French Language proficiency test before the beginning of the program in order to be placed in group **levels** (from A1 to C2).

The objectives of the language support program are defined by the principles of the <u>Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEFR)</u>: general and communication skills, task-based learning, language plurality and cultural awareness. Activities will depend of the language levels as well as the students' needs.

- ✓ Beginner: present and talk about one's self, background, likes, dislikes, find one's bearings, describe and talk about the past.
- ✓ Intermediate: describe and talk in the past tense, express one's preferences, explain choices.
- ✓ Advanced : express an opinion, present arguments and defend a point of view.

Students who choose to participate in the support classes will receive an **attendance certificate** at the end of the course with the number of hours taken and a written and oral grade. **Attendance is mandatory**. It is necessary to **take at least 30** out of the 40 hours of classes and **obtain an average passing grade** in written and oral evaluations. If these conditions are not fulfilled, the certificate will not be given.



The French Language level shown in the certificate corresponds to the group level.



Important! ECTS credits will not be given for these classes.
