Appendix 1: Amounts for stay costs

Stay costs

Duration of the mobility	Amount allocated	
Short stay (up to 30 days)		
Up to the 14 th day	€79/day	
From the 15 th to the 30 th day	€56/day	
Long stay (from 1 to 6 months)		
From 1 to 6 months	€700/month	

Inclusion support

Duration of the mobility	Amount allocated
Up to the 14 th day	€100
From the 15 th to the 30 th day	€150
From 1 to 6 months	€250/month

Eligibility for the inclusion support:

- Disability or long-term illness (ALD): inclusion mobility card or certificate of MDPH decision or certificate of long-term illness
- Living in a commune classified as a rural revitalization zone (ZRR): certificate of student's or parents' address (energy bill, water bill, home insurance, etc.) less than 3 months old at the time of application. If the participant's name does not appear on the proof of address, a sworn statement of family relationship or a copy of the family record book must be provided
- Living at an address classified as a priority urban district (quartier prioritaire de la ville): proof of address from the student or parents (energy bill, water bill, home insurance, etc.) dated less than 3 months before the date of application. If the participant's name does not appear on the proof of address, a sworn statement of family relationship or a copy of the family record book must be provided
- **Higher education grant holder on social criteria at levels 6 and 7:** notification of final grant award for the year of mobility.
